

SECTION 16: SCHEDULE OF CHANGES

The paragraphs below provide a schedule of the principal changes to this section of the Environmental Statement since the application to Cheshire County Council/amended application to the Department of Trade & industry, of 26 July 2007.

All Sections

- Minor textual changes to explain changes in the definitions of the applications (DTI to DBERR).

Section 16.1

- Additional text to explain the rationale behind the assessment of impact interactions.

Sections 16.2

- Assessment Methodology has been deleted and a replacement explanation provided in Section 1 (each individual technical section also has a description of the approach taken).

Section 16.3

- Major reconstruction of this section (now referred to as Section 16.2) to:
 - outline the approach to the cumulative assessment,
 - expand the assessment to include the larger number of developments being considered,
 - provide a summary of the predicted cumulative impacts for each development and allocation considered in the Environmental Statement technical sections, and
 - provide a summary matrix detailing the predicted cumulative impacts of the development with the other developments and allocations.

Section 16.5

- Sentence added to the first paragraph to clarify the purposes of this section.

Section 16.5.2

- Clarification provided with respect to the inclusion of air quality impacts on settlement receptors.

Section 16.5.4

- Further clarification of impacts upon the Mersey Estuary.

Table 16.1

- Summary table (Table 16.1) of how the different impacts of Quinn had been considered deleted since Quinn Glass is now operational. Previously it had been considered using ES data for air, noise etc impacts, yet buildings had been erected so these impacts were dealt with differently.

Table 16.2

- Table deleted since it was felt this added little to the descriptive text.
