

SECTION 6: SCHEDULE OF CHANGES

The paragraphs below provide a schedule of the principal changes to this section of the Environmental Statement since the application to Cheshire County Council/amended application to the Department of Trade & industry, of 26 July 2007.

All Sections and Tables

- Minor textual changes to provide clarity and explanation.

Section 6.2.1

- Comment to state that the study has been undertaken in accordance with CLR11 methodology.

Section 6.2.6

- Additional section referring to possible phasing of construction.

Section 6.3.1.3

- Additional reference to previous ground investigations by WSP. Addition of reference to ground conditions encountered during RSK investigation at Holme Farm lagoons.

Section 6.3.2.1 and 6.3.2.2

- Additional sections making reference to RSK investigation of soil nutrient status.

Section 6.3.3.1

- Addition of full licence reference number of waste treatment facility. Reference to RSK investigation at Holme Farm.
- Removal of comment regarding application of paper mill waste to soil. This is not considered to be of particular relevance due to this being a common practice.

Section 6.3.5.1

- Slight modification of paragraph to clarify proposed modification of site topography.
- References to sheet piling removed as this is not required.

Sections 6.4.1.1 and 6.4.1.2

- Sections merged (to become Section 6.4.1.1) to incorporate both specific and general construction related impacts.
- Addition of comments regarding significance of specific potential construction impacts. Addition of comment regarding potential impacts relating to use of piled foundations. Additional comment regarding silt management during possible phased construction.

Section 6.4.2.1

- Addition of comments regarding significance of potential operational impacts.

Section 6.4.3

- Section removed (Relevance of Potential Operational Impacts). Content incorporated into previous section.

Section 6.5.1

- Addition of further details relating to potential construction impacts, under the headings: Storage and handling of materials/oils/chemicals/; Refuelling of plant and equipment; Contaminated land; Concrete mixing; Invasive weeds; Silt management; Noise; Dust;

- Additional section discussing potential cumulative impacts, making reference to table in Chapter 1.
